Competition Venue Information	 All general warm-ups will take place in the lower hall, which is situated at the far side of Sport Wales. Can we politely ask that coaches remove outdoor shoes when entering the lower hall. There will an accreditation desk in the reception area of Sport Wales, where coaches can pick up their event accreditation. Gymnasts and coaches seating will be allocated in the first block of seats as you enter the hall - this will be clearly marked. Can we ask that all coaches and gymnasts utilise this area as the event is likely to be sold out, with spectators who have purchased tickets. The venue has lots of changing spaces for gymnasts and store their belongings safely.

Presentations	Welsh medals and trophies will be presented to all gymnasts in the open/closed category who finish in overall 1st position. Medals will be awarded to those finishing in overall silver and bronze overall. Apparatus medals will be presented to gymnasts finishing in 1st/2nd/3rd in all closed (only) categories. Once logged in you can find this event on the "Future Events" page and then select the "Music Upload" option.

To upload a gymnast(s) music:

- 1. Select your club to show a list of gymnasts.
- 2. Find the gymnast(s) you would like to upload music for.
- 3. Click 'Choose File' and select the appropriate file from your device.
- 4. Once uploaded you will be able to play the track to confirm it is correct.

If you accidentally upload the wrong music you can upload another track which will replace the original. Uploaded music can only be played by the user who uploaded it so nobody else will have access to your music.

If you can't find your gymnast(s) please email their music to music@gymdata.co.uk as the system may not be updated regularly with changes and late entries.

Please bring a copy of your music to the event (on USB) as a backup.
