




Welcome to our new Strategy...

We lead the sport, enabling gymnastics to thrive!


As the recognised governing body for gymnastic disciplines in Wales, our remit spans:

We have integrity and are always improving, with our community at the heart of our decision-making.






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

Prioritise Safeguarding & Wellbeing

Without compromise, the safeguarding and the wellbeing of our gymnasts will always be our highest priority. Safeguarding is the golden thread that runs through every aspect of our work, and throughout each goal. In safe and inclusive environments, a culture that ensures the voice of everyone in our community is heard, will continue to evolve. We all understand our responsibilities and are accountable for our actions.



Create a culture where everyone feels safe and valued. We all understand our role in ensuring our sport is safe and inclusive.

Ensure our Board of Directors are the custodians of safeguarding and wellbeing measures.

Work with parents so they can support the gymnast journey at all levels.

Actively listen to our gymnast voices and grow our community of Gymnast Ambassadors.

Continue to employ experienced safeguarding professionals.



Ensure all our places are safe, inclusive and accessible environments.

Create open access to our places, creating viewing areas or live digital feeds for parents.



Practices

Strive for continual improvement against our safeguarding and wellbeing plan, publishing our progress on an annual basis.

Protect the safeguarding budget against the risk of cost-cutting measures.

Continue to work with regulatory bodies to challenge unregulated sport, setting minimum agreed standards.

Maintain Level 3 Safeguarding Standard, awarded by NSPCC's Child Protection in Sport Unit.

Maintain compliance with the Social Services and Wellbeing Act (Wales) and Wales Safeguarding Procedures.

Maintain clear and transparent gymnast-friendly policies.







Enhance financial resilience

Financial resilience for Welsh Gymnastics and the wider gymnastics community will make our sport more sustainable. It requires strategic planning and the pursuit of commercially creative opportunities.



Work with gymnastics providers to identify mutually beneficial financial opportunities.

Forge closer working relationships with government agencies to support growth.

Ensure our membership offer provides value for all members.




Places

Enhance range of competitions and events that are staged in venues across Wales.

Work with schools to use gymnastics as part of the extension to the school day.

Strengthen partnerships with facilities to help meet unmet demand for gymnastics.



Retain the confidence of public finance investors by maintaining a high-level of governance.

Strike a balance between financial ambition and risk at board level.

Develop an evidence-based advocacy plan to support the case for financial investment among stakeholders.

Embrace technology to lower costs and increase commercial opportunities.

Identify economies of scale to share services across the sports sector.







Develop 'Fit for the Future' Facilities

Gymnastics in Wales has undergone a transformation, with the introduction of dedicated facilities, led largely by skilled, social entrepreneurs. But we must reach further into communities, forge new partnerships and enhance our delivery models to meet demand and further grow the sport.



People

Facilitate opportunities to enhance the business skills of facility operators, ensuring facilities are utilised to their fullest potential.

Match volunteer business mentors with those running facilities.

Launch a recruitment drive to ensure we have a workforce of facility operators that reflects the communities we serve.



Places

Deliver a National Gymnastics Centre for Wales.


Identify locations with latent demand and find solutions for new places, including shared spaces.

Develop a business model for mobile gyms, focussing on pre-school and foundation level gymnastics.

Negotiate financially sustainable lease agreements for dedicated facilities.

Plan to maximise the use of facility assets, working with statutory and non-statutory agencies.

Prioritise opportunities to develop environmentally sustainable facilities.



Ensure plans are insight-led.

Prioritise the financial viability of new and upgraded facilities and spaces to ensure sustainability.

Actively collaborate with planning authorities to advocate for the repurposing of industrial units, to create new gymnastics facilities.

Improve accessibility, considering public transport routes and ensuring disabled access.







Create Opportunities for Everyone

Demand for gymnastics and trampolining in Wales outstrips the supply of opportunities. We need to grow the sport in order to reduce waiting lists. From early years development to supporting the development of physical literacy, gymnastics provides the foundations of a healthy and active lifestyle.



People

Encourage participation from underrepresented groups and ensure our Hardship Fund supports those in need.

Build more diversity within our workforce and ensure training is accessible to all.

Increase employment opportunities throughout our network, enhancing our entrepreneurial workforce.

Provide ongoing support and education programmes that set clear standards to ensure highly trained, supportive workforce at every level.





Implement clear pathways for progression to performance

We will nurture a culture where everyone can achieve their full potential; and their own personal best. We will ensure our programmes are always athletecentred and coach-led.



People

Continue to create a culture of actively listening to the athlete voice, building programmes that are athlete-centred and coach-led.

Develop a wider cohort of coaches and support staff with world class knowledge, skills and behaviours.

Enhance subsidies for performance gymnastics so that financial barriers do not stand in the way of achieving potential.

Ensure Welsh representation at every level, role and discipline of the British Gymnastics pathway for Great Britain.

Ease the transition for gymnasts reaching the end of their careers either through talent transfer to other sports or into work.

Make training compulsory for parents and guardians if their child enters the performance pathway.



Places

Secure investment to develop a fit for purpose National Gymnastics Centre, with world-class facilities for performance gymnasts.

Develop an infrastructure of regional performance hubs, serving all disciplines.



Practices

Ensure alignment with British Gymnastics performance pathways in all disciplines.

Establish a Para performance programme to include high performance opportunities for para-athletes.

Create more equity across our disciplines in terms of investment and resource.

Regionalise our Performance programme to nurture talent in every corner of Wales.

Work collaboratively with the development team to ensure smooth transition from development to performance.
