- **Performance Update**

Brevet/National judging – Congratulations given to Nerys Williams, who retained her Brevet judging qualification for the next cycle. One further individual to attend online course later in the year.

Squad programme 2025 – Plans for 2025-26 programme well underway and will be shared in the next couple of weeks. Parent induction booked in for March squad session.

Budgets/investment – Despite Lottery Funding via Sport Wales reducing significantly, investment into the trampolining performance programme is increasing for 2025-26.

Equipment – 4 new Ultimate trampolines now delivered and being used in squad sessions and in clubs by performance squad gymnasts.

BG/Home Nations – ELW and RT attended a session hosted by BG to discuss selection policies for squads and international competitions. Joint HN camps planned (Wales and Scotland) for Summer 2025.

- **Development Update**

Education – Level 3 modules will run even if low numbers. Welsh Squad members will be offered the opportunity to take a Level 1 coaching course.

Judging (Up to regional) – Old code will be used in competitions until Welsh Championships, where new code will be used in FIG competition. Nerys will deliver a workshop for judges on the new code if required pre-Welsh.

New provision – New trampoline club starting in Anglesey. Delyn also looking to deliver trampoline sessions.

TAI plan – Pilots planned for second half of the year. Delyn to host a pilot in North Wales (August). Two other pilots to be planned – likely to include a Higher of Further education establishment.

Competitions – 2025 Competition Handbook is near completion and will be circulated shortly.

- **Safeguarding Update**

Safe environments – Safe environment policy went live in Jan 2025. Coaches are required to sign up to the Coach Register via Sport80 – pre requisites will be checked (DBS, SPC and Membership). Not having these will impact ability to access WG environments. DBS seem to be taking a long time, so advised to start process early if new one is required. Open environments now required so parents/guardians can view their children, this can help to protect coaches/staff from allegations. Promote how to report a concern at all clubs and competitions (poster with a QR code) – not just for gymnasts to use. Coaches must be up to date with the Home Nation Safe practice policies, these can be found on WG website. Next policies to be launched are Nutrition and Training + Loading. Safe environment policy also contains useful ratio table and information on qualifications required per role.
